Round 11 and the schedule had the Northwest Lightning 12s fixed with a sense of trepidation for a catchup with the elusive Lane Cove Cats at Blackman Oval.

And with those extra numbers in hand on the bench, the Lightning could afford to run themselves ragged, knowing there was a well-rested sideline ready to step in.

The focus on ferocious kicked in, locking down the defence, putting the handbrake on Lane Cove's scoring opportunities, and edging the scores back to near-level-pegging by the final change. Which is when it all came together: the Lightning were able to put together a flurry of fourth-quarter footy, a clutch of quick goals from great across-the-ground teamwork to put the result beyond doubt.
